## 2021 H 6070 RELATING TO EDUCATION - CURRICULUM

We, the undersigned, wish to formally express our concerns with *H 6070 - 16-22-34*. *Prohibition of teaching divisive concepts*. Given our cultural and societal climate and the urgent need to steer directly into historical realities of systemic racism, now is not the time to continue to employ a "color blind" approach to educating Rhode Island's children.

H 6070 is a distraction from focusing on the symptoms of racism and sexism instead of the causes. It is rooted in the fictitious idea that racism and sexism are essentially over and that these systems have not damaged our society, our economy and our country. Furthermore, the majority of your constituents are against H 6070.

Racism still exists everywhere. It began with the slave trade and has continued over time atrocity by atrocity, injustice by injustice, law by law, neighborhood by neighborhood. For those who disagree with this hard truth by arguing that it is exaggerating our country's racial circumstances and tarnishes our self-image, only make clear they do not understand our American history. Failing to see the greater opportunity to provide all students with a high-quality, developmentally appropriate educational content and instruction rooted in truth, and equity-minded is an injustice to our children and will not advance our shared humanity.
